that I am a jurist and elector in the First Estate of _____ County, Texas, which also participates as Congregation _____ of the Texian Jural Society and as Congregation _____ of the National Jural Society, and is that certain society of sovereign souls domiciled on the land described by the boundaries of Texas, and each Texas county, that peaceably and lawfully Assemble in Order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common Defense, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty for our Posterity and our free and independent county and state and the Honor of our County, State, and Country and to provide, grand juries within the Texian Jural Society for each county, the state and the national causes of action, such juries to be known as the:

First Estate of republic State of Texas Grand Jury,
First Estate of republic State of Texas National District Grand Jury and
First Estate of National Grand Jury

respectively, and to provide three separate and distinct republican forms of government, including one for the county, one for the state and one for the national; and to these ends does each sovereign soul solemnly and mutually, covenant and combine themselves together into a civil Body Politic, for their better Ordering and Preservation, and Furtherance of the Ends aforesaid; Further, does each Texian sovereign soul solemnly and mutually pledge to each and every other Texian sovereign soul to come to their defense against any unjust or unrighteous assault or threat, either by direct or indirect acts, on any Texian sovereign soul's life, liberty or property; And by Virtue hereof to enact, constitute, and frame, such just and equal Laws, Ordinances, Acts, Constitutions and Offices, from time to time, as shall be thought most meet and convenient for the General good; unto which we promise all due submission and obedience.

I pray that I may always act in a manner that honors all of the above and will insure that we will always have a lawful, righteous and just government that truly represents the Texian People. That my purpose and goal will always be liberty, by learning to become a better sovereign jurist and elector and will to the best of my ability insure the continued process of electing righteous and just fellow sovereigns to hold the government offices.

Declaration of Sovereign Rights held by Indigenous Power

In The Beginning Almighty God created all men and women with equal rights; that they are created with Sovereign Rights held by Indigenous Power and endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights. A free and independent state is established when one people join together in a common unity to secure their natural God-given rights and sovereignty. To secure their sovereignty and right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; to be exercised by elected officials as surrogate power for the free and independent state.

When surrogate power officials assume the rights of sovereign Indigenous Power as supreme; a free and independent state inverts into a state which usurps the sovereignty of the people and they become mere subjects of mandatory conformity, victims of suppression of natural rights and tyranny. Corrupted surrogate power has no indigenous authority of its own, therefore, I declare by Almighty God in peaceable One People Assembly:

Covenant Affirmation

I am created equal to all men and women with Sovereign Rights held by Indigenous Power. I solemnly affirm, publish and declare; **I am** absolved from all political allegiance foreign to these free and independent states of the Republic for the united States of America. With a firm reliance on the protection of Divine providence, in One People Assembly; I affirm:

I am local to Texas, a Free and Independent state; lawfully settled in _____ county Settlement

and in Order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common Defense, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty for our Posterity and our free and independent state; I consent to uphold and keep the Peace or delegate power of Sovereign Rights held by Indigenous Power to the local county settlement and to Texas, a Free and Independent state, for the lawful Protections, Freedoms, and Rights of the sovereign people in these free and independent states of the Republic [of] for the united States of America. In support to this Declaration, with a firm reliance on Divine Providence we mutually pledge to the sovereign people of Texas our lives, our fortunes and our sacred honor. By autograph under Witness Protection my Declaration of Sovereign Rights held by Indigenous Power is supreme.

Declaration of Intent to Assemble and Adhere to the Standards of a Jurist

I hereby solemnly declare and publish that I am a man or woman, having attained the age of twenty-one years, created of the Almighty, indigenous to the land, bound by the natural law; and with allegiance pledged to no one, never having sworn allegiance; or having pledged allegiance in the past, and having seen my error; revoked, or hereby revoke, the same, by and through my inherent and indigenous powers, I declare to the world that I am free and possessed of all my faculties, and that:

I am local to the _____ settlement, peacefully and honorably settled in an area described as _____ county, Texas, which I have made my permanent, as opposed to temporary, abode, and that by the powers aforesaid, I declare my intent to assemble and cognize the duties and powers of a jurist.

A Jurist is one that knows, engages in and will uphold matters of law. A jurist may be called to serve on a grand jury panel, or a petit jury, or remain in a jury pool as a reserve. Once empanelled and sworn in, a jurist may also be called upon to investigate a crime, or may investigate on his own initiative. A jurist might be appointed to public office, or may be nominated for election, and upon being seated upon a jury panel, whether grand or petit, or upon taking a public office, shall be required to give such sureties and covenants to solemnize the conviction of resolve to truly discharge the duties of office, protect the innocent, and charge the office with the authority of law.
